

WGPRA POOL RULES

1. Wrestling, throwing people in the pool, or horseplay on the pool deck is prohibited
2. Wrestling, horseplay or throwing people/children in the pool is prohibited
3. Inappropriate language (cursing, slurs, derogatory insults) is not permitted
4. Diving Board & Deep End Swimming Rules
 - Patrons may ask the lifeguards to open/close the diving board. The lifeguard will blow their whistle according to the request, and make the announcement
 - When the diving board is OPEN: the deep end is closed for free swim
 - When the diving board is CLOSED: the deep end is open for free swim
5. Adult swim is for guests 18 years and older. Adult swim occurs during the ten minute breaks every hour at :50
6. Guests should not initiate conversations with lifeguards on duty (emergencies only) for all guests safety..
7. Running on the pool deck is not permitted
8. Baby pool Rules
 - **An adult (18+)** must supervise children in the baby pool area at all times as there is no lifeguard on duty monitoring this area.
 - Children in the baby pool area should be **5 years or younger**
9. If your child requires a flotation device, an adult 18 years or older must keep the child within arms reach.
10. Children under 12 must have an adult chaperone at the pool with them at all times.
11. Children 12-15 can use the pool without a parent, provided they have passed a swim test. Children 16 and up do not need to visit the pool with an adult (18+) chaperone. This can also be changed for anyone depending on circumstances.
12. Glass bottles, drinkware, and dishware are not permitted at any time.
13. Float policy
 - Small personal floats (no rafts or large floats) are permitted if the total headcount is less than 100 people inside the gate
 - If more than 100 people are inside the gate, **or** if the lifeguards on duty feel there is a safety concern, floats will not be allowed
 - Once the capacity has dropped back down and the safety concern is no longer present, floats will be allowed
 - Floats are not allowed in the shallow end or deep end.
14. Drugs and alcohol are not permitted on the property. If renting the pool for an event, please see the alcohol policy stated on the Pool Party Form, which is applicable for after hours pool rental only.
15. Pets are not allowed
16. Shoes must be worn when entering the poolhouse and/or bathroom
17. Guests are permitted with a member for \$10/person per day. Out of town guests are free with a member. Out of town is defined as 50+ miles away.
18. **LIFEGUARDS AND ADULT VOLUNTEERS IN THE SNACKBAR AND CHECKING GUESTS IN MAY PUT GUESTS IN A TIME OUT OR ASK GUESTS TO LEAVE AS THEY NEED TO IN ORDER TO KEEP ALL OF OUR GUESTS SAFE.**
19. **LIFEGUARDS AND ADULTS VOLUNTEERS IN THE SNACKBAR AND CHECKING IN HAVE FULL AUTHORITY OF THE WGPRA BOARD TO ENFORCE THESE RULES.**
